

GOVERNMENT: Brockport prepares for dissolution vote

The Brockport Village Board has scheduled several meetings about an election that could dissolve the village.

During last night's meeting, board members approved a May 6 public meeting with representatives of the Center for Governmental Research. That'll happen at 6 p.m. at Village Hall, 49 State Street. The meeting occurs ahead of two public information forums, which will be led by CGR and the League of Women Voters.

The first public forum is scheduled for May 26 and the second for June 8. Both are scheduled to start at 7 p.m. at Oliver Middle School's auditorium, 40 Allen Street.

Village Board members are waiting for the outcome of the June 15 election to start work on a dissolution plan, says village Clerk Leslie Ann Morelli. If voters decide to dissolve the village, board members will have six months to come up with a dissolution plan.
