Princeton Township Municipal Building 2nd Floor










Existing Space Analysis: Programmatic Relationships & Adjacencies




Police & Public Safety Area Diagram - Borough Hall






Circulation Pattern from Holding Cells to Court Room - Township Building




Circulation Pattern from Holding Cells to Court Room - Borough Hall







Summary of Recommendations:

Borough Hall

- Affordable Housing (west upper level)
- Human Services (west upper level)
- Health Department (west upper level)
- Fire Inspection (east upper level)
- Public Works dept, and SOC management personnel (east upper level)
- Downtown Administrative Offices (Mayor & Administrator)
- Corner House (west lower level)
- Space to be offered to TV30 on a rental basis (east lower level, including possible use of the sally port)
- Community and Municipal meeting room (present Borough Council Room)
- Unassigned space that could be modified for future municipal or community use

Township Municipal Complex

- Police Dept and Police Dispatch (present locations)
- Municipal Court, Violations Bureau and supporting functions (present locations)
- Mayor, Administrator and Municipal Clerk's office (present locations)
- Engineering Dept, Zoning and Historic Preservation (present locations)
- Planning, Building and Construction Departments (present locations)
- Township Committee /Court Room and Community Room to be kept for municipal and community use

Princeton Facilities Consolidation

Request for Action:

- 1. Approve recommendation for department locations
- Authorize administrators to request a proposal from KSS for a Phase 2 of the Facilities work. In Phase 2: the layout and modifications will be designed per recommendations for location of departments. Prepare bid packages and contracts for facilities modifications.
- 3. Conduct a separate study to define the extent of the potential parking problem at both buildings after the merger and to recommended solutions.
- 4. Separate Study of File Storage Management and Archiving
- 5. Manage Phase 2 through the professional staff with oversight by the subcommittee on behalf of the TTF as needed.
